St. Dymphna

Born in Ireland to a pagan king sometime before the middle of the 13th century (when her veneration was first recorded), Dymphna became a Christian convert. After the death of her mother, her deranged father demanded to marry her, a beautiful young woman who resembled his late wife. She refused and fled to Antwerp with the help of her priest. She moved to the town of Geel, where her father eventually found her. He reiterated his demand to marry her; she again refused. He had his servants kill the priest, but he himself cut off his daughter's head. St. Dymphna is the patron saint of people suffering from mental illness and emotional and nervous afflictions, and of victims of incest.
