All requirements will be given prior to the scheduled Baptism.

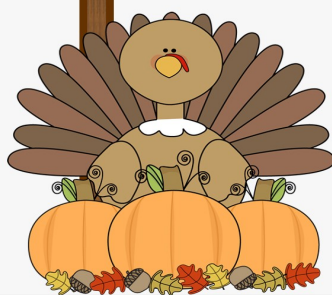
Weddings & Quinceañeras
