According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, each faithful of right discerning age is "bound by an obligation faithfully to confess serious sins at least once a year." (CCC 1457) Some might be tempted to just do the minimum. The Church allows it at one per year after all. But diligent self-examination will reveal that almost each one of us, if not all, actually sin several times-making a yearly Confession simply not enough.
